CARE FOR YOUR SURGICAL SITE

You have just had a surgical procedure performed on your skin.

The care that the site receives impacts the healing of the wound and the ultimate appearance of the skin.

- 1. Remove the bandage the day following your procedure.
- 2. Wash the site with soap and water, removing any crust or drainage.
- 3. Pat dry and apply Vaseline or Aquaphor, and apply a fresh bandage.
- 4. Continue to clean the site and replace the bandage daily for 3-5 days or until drainage subsides.

The risk of infection is very low. However, please call my office with any increase in drainage, redness, swelling or pain.
